- Undertake comprehensive weatherization improvements through air sealing and insulation
- Replace all or part of your heating system with modern wood heat, renewable natural gas, or heat pumps
- Reduce transportation costs by riding the bus, sharing rides, walking or biking
- Meet all or part of your electrical needs through solar energy
- Install battery storage
